

Where The Funding Goes



Current Structure of the Program



Major and Minor Funding

Minor: up to \$2,000

Major: from \$2,001 to \$15,000

4 rounds per year

- Delivery of one-off projects, events and activities for the benefit of the Ipswich local government area.
- Community projects that address local needs and achieve community development outcomes
- Community led art initiatives, including partnerships or collaborations with community art organisations, that increase engagement in art and cultural activities across the wider community
- Programs that increase physical activity and/or encourage participation in community level sport, recreation or physical activity
- Programs and events that activate public spaces and facilities
- Programs that create partnerships with local, state and national sporting organisations
- Community led initiatives that address local environmental priorities


